Introduction

Certification under the PEFC Lithuanian Forest Certification System (LFCS) shall be carried out by Certification Body (CB) that posses accreditation issued by National Accreditation Body (NAB) that is a member of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and/or European co-operation for Accreditation (EA) that is signatory of the Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA) for Quality Management Systems certification of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF).

In the process of building the PEFC LFCS, National Governance Bodies (NGB's) from Lithuania was participating and accepted the PEFC Lithuanian Forest Certification System.

Certification bodies carrying out forest management certification shall be accredited by the NAB in the country is eligible to operate forest management certification according to requirements of the PEFC LFCS.

In the countries that are participating in the PEFC LFCS and where NAB have not developed accreditation procedures, any CB that is accredited by any of the NAB from the countries that are participating in the PEFC LFCS is eligible to operate forest management certification.

Notification issued by of the National Governance Body (NGB) that is participating in the Lithuanian Forest Certification System (hereafter the NGB) establishes a necessary link between accredited certification bodies and the scheme owners and allows certification bodies to issue certificates recognised by the NGB's.

1. Scope

This document describes procedures for the issuance of notification by the NGB to certification bodies operating:

- a) Forest Management certification against the requirements of the PEFC National Standard for Sustainable Forest Management in Lithuania and/or
- b) Chain of Custody certification in Lithuania.

This document was approved by the NGB's participating in the PEFC LFCS and shall be applied for all certification bodies carrying out forest management and/or chain of custody certification against the PEFC LFCS.

3. Terms and definitions

3.1 Accredited certificate

A certificate issued by a certification body within the scope of its accreditation which bears the accreditation body's symbol.

3.2 PEFC authorized body

An entity authorised by the PEFC Council to administer the PEFC scheme on behalf of the PEFC Council.

Note: The authorised body is either the PEFC National Governing Body (NGB) operating within its country or another entity which has been authorised by the PEFC Council to administer the PEFC scheme.

4. Conditions for notification by the NGB

The certification body applying for notification by the NGB shall:


- be a legal entity;
- agree to be listed on the publicly available, web based PEFC Information Register, including the certification body's identification data and / or other data as specified by the PEFC Council and/or the NGB;
- sign a notification contract with the NGB (Appendix 1).
- a) The certification body applying for notification for Forest Management certification under Lithuanian Forest Certification System shall have valid accreditation, issued by National Accreditation Body (NAB) that is a member of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and/or European co-operation for Accreditation (EA) that is signatory of the Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA) for Quality Management Systems certification of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF).

The accreditation shall be issued against ISO/IEC 17021-1 (most recent version) and the scope of the accreditation shall explicitly include PEFC National Standard for Sustainable Forest Management in Lithuania in its valid version.

b) The certification body applying for notification for Chain of Custody certification under the LFCS shall have valid accreditation, issued by an accreditation body that is signatory of the Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA) for product certification of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF). The accreditation shall be issued against ISO/IEC 17065 (most recent version) and the scope of the accreditation shall explicitly include PEFC ST 2002:2020, Chain of Custody of Forest Based Products – Requirements, in its valid version.

The notification procedure does not include any discriminatory measures, such as the certification body's country of origin, affiliation to an association, etc.

5. Notification issuance procedures



6. Obligations of the notified certification body

The certification body (CB) notified by the NGB shall:

- 1. Pay the NGB an annual notification fee for every certificate when issued by the CB. The amount of the fee is specified in Appendix 3, *Tariffs of the Notification Fee* and can be changed by the NGB during the validity of the contract. Any change to the contract between the NGB and the notified certification body resulting from a change in the rates will take effect the year following that in which the NGB has informed the certification body, in writing, of the change.
- 2. Agree to be listed on the publicly available, web based PEFC Information Register, including the certification body's identification data and/or other data as may be specified by the PEFC Council and/or the NGB.
- 3. Inform certificate holders about the range of information it is reported to the NGB and that this information (except the certificate holders' turnover) will be made publicly available on the PEFC Information Register.
- 4. Inform the certificate holder how to obtain a PEFC Logo use license from the NGB.

6.1. Forest management certification

The certification body notified by the NGB for Forest Management certification shall:

1. Have and keep valid accreditation issued in compliance with PEFC LT 04:2024, Certification and accreditation procedures and inform the NGB immediately about any

changes in the accreditation. Upon request it shall provide updated evidence that it still meets the requirements of valid accreditation.

- 2. Carry out Forest Management certification against PEFC National Standard for Sustainable Forest Management in Lithuania within the scope of the valid accreditation.
- 3. Provide the NGB immediately and truthfully with a completed reporting form for each PEFC Forest Management certificate issued within the scope of notification and on changes concerning reported certificates.
- 4. Provide the NGB, upon request, with a list of Forest Management certificates issued under the scope of notification by the NGB, including information defined in the reporting form in the appendix to this document.

6.2. Chain of Custody certification

The certification body notified by the NGB for Chain of Custody certification shall:

- 1. Have and keep valid accreditation issued in compliance with PEFC ST 2003:2020 and inform the NGB immediately about any changes in the accreditation. Upon request it shall provide updated evidence that it still meets the requirements of valid accreditation.
- 2. Carry out PEFC chain of custody certification against PEFC ST 2002:2020 within the scope of the valid accreditation.
- 3. Provide the NGB immediately and truthfully with a completed reporting form for each Chain of Custody certificate and every site covered by a multi-site certificate, issued under the scope of notification by the NGB and on changes concerning reported certificates.
- 4. Provide the NGB, upon request, with a list on certificates issued under the scope of notification by the NGB, including information defined in the reporting form in the appendix to this document.

6.3. Check on fulfillment of requirements of PEFC Logo Usage Rules

The certification body notified by the NGB for Chain of Custody certification shall:

- 1. Carry out PEFC logo usage veryfication against PEFC ST 2001:2020 and PEFC LT 04:2024 within the scope of the valid accreditation.
- 2. Provide the NGB immediately and truthfully for PEFC logo use by certified entities issued under the scope of notification by the NGB and on changes concerning reported certificates.

7. Validity of notification

The notification is valid for the period of the validity of the certification body's accreditation. The notification can be terminated or suspended immediately by the NGB, if the notification contract is violated.

a) Forest Management certification

The PEFC national governing body charges amount of 0,02 EURO annually per hectare of forest certified by PEFC Forest Management standard(s).

The use of PEFC logo must be aproved with a logo usage contract.

Note: The calculation of the notification fee takes into account the total forest area, regardless of coownership.

In case of multi-site certifications, which are not producer groups, the multi-site organisation's turnover is calculated as a sum of turnovers of sites covered by the multisite organisation.

National governing body issues the PEFC logo to certified companies free of charge. The contribution of companies is paid through a certification body, which collects the contribution for the institution.

The use of PEFC logo is free for certified COC companies. The logo use must be aproved with a logo usage contract.
